Queen Contest Code of Conduct

The NJQH Queen is a spokesperson and repetitive of NJQHA. As Queen I agree to abide by the following code of conduct:

- * I will represent NJQHA to the best of my ability and agree to act at all times in a helpful, respectful and dignified manner.
- * I pledge to be helpful to all members, visitors and guests at NJQHA functions, meetings and horse shows etc.
- * When I visit other horse shows as a representative of NJQHA I will be punctual, friendly and willing to help with whatever is asked of me.
- * Because I am a role model for all members of AQHA and NJQHA both adult and Youth, I agree to maintain a Clean internet image.
 - * I will not post profane or obscene comments or photos on personal or group websites such as Facebook and My Space
 - * I agree not to display images or comments condoning alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drug use
 - * I agree not to consume alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs when representing NJQHA at functions including but not limited to horse shows, meetings and the All-American Congress
- * NJQHA encourages its Queen to maintain these standards at other public functions particularly where other AQHA and NJQHA members are likely to attend

Upon being crowned, the new Queen will be asked to sign this Code of Conduct. Refusal to sign causes title to be awarded to 1st runner-up. First violation initiates a written warning. A second infraction leads revoking of Queen status.
