

Application Deadline: April 30, 2024

The applicant must be a current member in good standing and comply with all AQHA and NJQHA rules and regulations. The applicant must be 18-25 years of age (as of 1/1 of competing year). Applicant may not be married, divorced, or a single parent. Upon marriage or becoming pregnant Queen must relinquish her crown to the first runner-up. Applicants may serve as NJQHA Queen no more than two consecutive times. Judging will be as follows:

- 1. Personal Interview 40%: The interview will be conducted by a three-person panel to be held at the NJQHA Show, 2024. The date and time are to be determined. Interview will include but not be limited to, for example: a discussion of the application and its information, rules, and regulations of AQHA and NJQHA. Judging will be based on answers, written speech, poise, personality, overall presentation, articulation, and the completed Congress Queen Application, including pictures, presented at interview.
- 2. Written Test 40%: The written test will be held immediately following the personal interview. The written test will be comprised of 20 questions (true/false, multiple choice and fill in the blanks). Questions will be taken from the current year's AQHA Official Handbook of Rules and Regulations (75%) and NJQHA Bylaws and Rules (25%). Answers must exactly match the corresponding source to be considered correct.
- 3. Horsemanship/Equitation 20%: The horsemanship/equitation class will be judged by a three-person panel and will be held at NJQHYA show, exact date and time to be determined. The class will consist of pattern work as determined by judges and rail work. The class is to be judged per AQHA Rule 431 thru 437.4. The applicant may show any AQHA registered quarter horse.

All applicants will be given a score in each portion of the contest that will determine the overall results. In the event of a tie the person scoring highest in the personal interview will be crowned NJQHA Queen.

The applicant that is crowned is expected to: 1) adhere to the NJQHA Code of Conduct, 2) participate in the Congress Queen Contest, 3) assist in presenting awards at the NJQHYA 2024 Show, 4) Banquet for 2024,

5) assist with one promotional booth presentation, 6) assist in future NJQHA Queen Contests including the crowning of the Queen the following year, and 7) be a spokesperson for NJQHA.

NJQHA will supply the Queen's Crown and Sash. NJQHA will provide \$675 to help cover the Congress application fee which covers the hotel fee at Congress for the contest. This payment will be made after the Queen has completed the Congress competition. The applicant, with the assistance of NJQHA and NJQHYA will be responsible for raising funds for all other expenses (personal transportation, horse transportation, food (human and equine)

etc. All funds raised will	be made payable to NJQH	A then reimbursed to the Queen	for expenses. The Queen will
